IMPORTANT FEE INFORMATION

- Changes or additions to the original contract after June 1, 2010, will be subjected to a \$20 change fee. A change fee is defined as any adjustment to the original registration, including additions. All changes to the original contract must be submitted in writing to be considered valid.
- All deposits are nonrefundable. All cancellations/deletions made after June 1, 2010, will be subjected to a \$90 per week cancellation fee. If a cancellation/deletion is for medical reasons, a doctor's note **MUST** be submitted and credit for the specified lost time will be issued.
- A late fee of \$50 per month will be charged to any invoice that remains unpaid as of August 13, 2010.

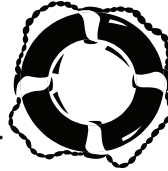
