We're all winners!

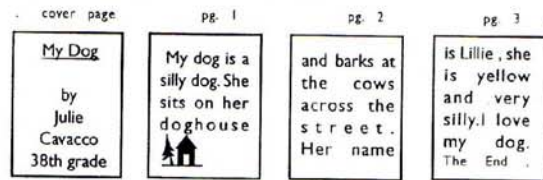
With corrections!

For all grades K-6th it is a home centered project not a class requirement. The work submitted can be newly written or an older piece that the child wants to submit.

It's not a competition but a chance to share their work with pride. It is important for parents and families to support their efforts by attending the fair. If you can not make it please ensure that your child will go with a friend or family member. We take over the cafeteria and the work is formally presented. It's impressive! The deadline of for submissions is Friday, February 12th. You may give your work to your teacher or the front office before vacation. 1) Put all work on regular sized paper (like this 8 1/2 by 11 piece)

- It may be on more than one page but try to keep it to 3 pages or less.
- Include drawings, if you'd like.
- It should be on one side only.



2) Make a cover page

- Include your name, grade and title
- Include a drawing, if you'd like, on the cover page or as one of the 3 pages.

3) How neat should your poem or story be?

- Very neat! It can be computer typed by student or adult or handwritten but it should be your best work- something to be proud of.
- We're going to affix it to mat board and make it look like a book.

4) Return your work to the school office or to your teacher

- The orientation of the page should be tall- like this sheet and not wide. In the computer it may say portrait (NOT landscape)
- Make a "book" cover with your name, date and grade on it.
- You may hand write it or have your work typed by yourself or an adult. It needs to be something that you are proud of.
- For all of your artwork- use markers or colored pencils.
- Many people will get a chance to read your poem or story. Take the time to prepare it so it represents your best work!
- We will mount your work on matte board and display them in the cafeteria for the Writing Fair on Tuesday, March 9th.
